In the period 2004-2018, 29,528 ha of agricultural land were privatized in the total amount of $€ 117,071,018$.

The average of employees in agriculture businesses in the period 2014-2018, was 10,085 . In 2018 there was an increase of 25.9\% compared to 2017.
