

GDP with the current prices of 2018 was \in 6,726 mil.




Real growth in 2018 compared to 2017 was 3.82%.





The GDP per capita in 2018 was € 3,746.

Agriculture sector as a very important and strategic economic activity for our country contributes 7% to GDP.




Crop and livestock production for 2014-2018, in million (EUR)



The area cultivated with FORAGE CROPS AND GREEN HARVESTED CEREALS in 2018 is 107,099 ha






Milk is the most important livestock product, in 2018 contributes with **103.2** out of a total of 131.5 million euros in livestock products.








The production of sheep and goat meat in 2018 was about 2,116 tons of carcass weight.








The main partners for the export of agricultural products to the EU for 2018 are:

Directs Payments

In 2018, subsidies reached the amount of € 29.6 million, of which 90% was spent on:

- o wheat,
- o dairy cows,
- o corn,
- o vegetables,
- o existing vineyards,
- o bees,
- o sheep and goats,
- o existing orchards.

The budget planned for implementing the rural development program for 2018 was € 19 million.

The rural development program in 2018 consisted of the following measures:
