



Kosova Agriculture in Numbers

2022

Introduction

The publication "Agriculture in Figures 2022" presents a summary of selected key statistical indicators related to the agricultural sector, presenting in a more accessible way the current development trends of the sector. This publication is prepared by the Department of Statistics and Economic Analysis, which offers a faster and easier access to numbers, figures and statistics from many other dimensions of the agricultural sector, including general statistics such as: Gross Domestic Product, population, the unemployment rate, the main statistics of agriculture in Kosova, the participation of agriculture in GDP, the trade exchange of agricultural products and its participation in the total export/import as well as the trade balance, data on land use divided by the category. The publication also presents the data on the economic accounts, which include the products of the agricultural industry and other main components of the economic accounts, the data on the prices of agricultural inputs and products, the data on agricultural and livestock production, which include plant production, livestock as well as some indicators from supply balances. Other data presented are data on the trade of agricultural products divided by groups of main agricultural products and by country, data on agro-credits, data on the support of the agriculture and rural development sector (direct payment and development measures rural).

Events from recent years such as the COVID-19 pandemic and the war in Ukraine have highlighted the urgent need for accurate statistics so that we can provide timely responses and monitor development trends for food security at the national level while formulating policies for sectoral development of agriculture in Kosovo. Therefore, the Department of Economic Analysis and Agricultural Statistics (DEAAS) is committed to providing access to current, reliable and timely data, required to determine the direction of a sector.

The source of the information in the publication is the organizational units of the MAFRD, the Agency for the Development of Agriculture (ADA) and the Statistics Agency of Kosova (ASK).

Summary

Based on the geographical configuration and climatic conditions, Kosovo has conditions and potential for the development of agriculture, taking into account that nearly half of the territory or 420,327 ha is classified as the utilized area of agricultural land. In 2021, agriculture together with forestry contributed 6.9% to the total value of the Gross Domestic Product and nearly 23% to total employment. In 2021, the value of the Gross Domestic Product at current prices was 7,957 million. €, with GDP per capita in the amount of €4,486. The unemployment rate at the country level was 20.7%. The total utilized area of agricultural land was 420, 327 ha, and is presented with this categorization structure in percentage as follows; Meadows and pastures (including common land) with a share of 52%, Arable land-fields 43%, Vegetables (in open field and greenhouses as first crop), gardens and nurseries 2%, Tree plantations 2% as well as Vineyard plantations 1%. According to the latest Agricultural Hausehold Survey 2021, there was an increase in the area of agricultural land used by only 0.03% compared to 2020. The biggest increase is in the areas with vegetables in greenhouses for 2.8%, nurseries for 2.4%, tree plantations and vineyards with 1% as well as vegetables in the open field 0.7%.

The value of products from the food industry in 2021 was 699 million. ϵ , which represents an increase in 2021 compared to 2020 for 24%. In the framework of the activities of agricultural businesses in 2021, the processing of food products with a value of 365.5 million had the largest participation. ϵ , followed by other activities of the agro-industry which are the production of beverages 150.9 mil. ϵ , plant and animal production, hunting and related services 74.5 mil. ϵ , production of wood and wood and cork products, except for furniture 58.6 mil. ϵ , as well as other activities that were of lesser value. Based on the Economic Accounts for Agriculture 2021, it appears that the value of plant and livestock products at current prices for 2021 was 809 mil. ϵ , of which the value of plant products reached 532 mil. ϵ , while the value of livestock production is 277 million. ϵ ., where it is also presented as the year where the value of plant production was higher for the period 2017-2021. The production value of the agricultural industry in 2021 was higher during this time period, and compared to the previous year, it increased by 3.4%, while intermediate

consumption decreased by 3.5%. The gross value added, which represents the difference between the value of the production of the agricultural industry and the value of intermediate consumption, in 2021 had the value of 453 million. ϵ , where compared to the previous year it decreased by 9.4%.

The value of income in agriculture in 2021, entrepreneurial income was -13.5% lower than in the previous year. Gross value added and net value added decreased by 9.4% and 13.5% respectively. The most important category for 2021 is intermediate consumption, which accounts for about 70.8%, followed by consumption of fixed capital, with 26.6%, while other categories have a smaller percentage of their participation.

Regarding the annual Index of prices of inputs related to the structure of intermediate agricultural consumption for 2021, the largest participation was the category of animal feed contributing 51%, fertilizers, soil improvers 12%, agricultural services 7%, other goods and services 9%, energy expenditure 8%, seeds and planting material 4%, veterinary expenditure 3%, material maintenance 3%, while plant protection products, pesticides and building maintenance have lower participation.

The annual index of inputs in 2021 has increased by 11.5% for Input 1, compared to the same period of 2020, while the index for Input 2 increased by 5.0%. The general input price index (Input 1 + Input 2) compared to 2020, in 2021 has increased by 8.3%. The categories that recorded a price increase in 2021 compared to 2020 were complex fertilizers (30.1%), followed by simple fertilizers (29.4%). There was also a significant increase in fuels (19.1%) within the category "Energy; Lubricants" and simple food substances (9.7%), composite food substances (8.6%) within the category "Animal feed". An increase of less than 2% had: Maintenance of materials (0.3%), Electricity (0.7%), Seeds and planting material (1.0%) as well as inputs presented as "Other" with 1.6%.

In 2021, some prices of agricultural products at the farm level marked a decrease in 2021 compared to 2020: table grapes, honey, eggs, pumpkin and corn, while the biggest increase in prices from the products was noted: raspberry, cucumber, tomato, spinach, apples, etc.

Due to the unfavorable climatic conditions, most of the crops compared to the previous year have decreased. When we talk about the **agricultural production**, cereals have had a decrease in area, by 0.2%, and also the production of cereals has decreased by 4.7%, except for rye which had an increase of 22.2% and other grain cereals 3.3%, which, despite the fact that the yield has decreased, the increase in surface area affected the increase in total production. Vegetables had an increase in area by 0.8%, while a decrease in production was observed by 2.7%. The area with ochards in 2021 has an increase of 1.1%, while the production was lower compared to 2020 by 6.5%. The areas with vineyards have increased by only 1%. Areas with table grapes increased by 2.9%, while those with wine grapes increased by 0.3%. Regarding production, there was a low growth of only 0.7%.

The cattle fund in 2021 was 260,528 heads, with a participation in the livestock fund of 47.3%, which shows a decrease compared to 2020 by 0.3%. The most important category within cattle are dairy cows, which represent 50.7% of the total number of cattle. Sheep and goats are presented with a number of 241,393 heads and represent 43.8% of the livestock fund, pigs with 47,384 heads or 8.6%, and horses with a number of 1,864 heads and had a smaller participation with only 0.3%. In 2021, the total **number of** poultry increased by 0.2% compared to 2020. While the number of hens per egg (94.8% of the number of poultry) in 2021 increased by 2.9%, the number of broilers decreased by 9.9 %. Out of the total number of chickens, the majority are laying hens (75.5%), followed by broilers (13.1%) and the category of birds, turkeys and other chickens (11.4%). Total egg production in 2021 is estimated to be 419.9 million. Eggs, which compared to 2020 shows an increase of 14.9%. The beekeeping sector in 2021 marked a decrease of 16.6% in the number of hives compared to 2020. The amount of import depends on local production in the corresponding year and this is also reflected in the degree of self-sufficiency for agricultural products, which for some of the most agricultural products cultivated in 2021 was as follows: Cereals (Wheat 69.6% and Corn 78.0%), Vegetables (Tomatoes 50.8%, Peppers 84.9%, Potatoes 92.4%) and Orchards and Vineyards (Apples 77.6%, Plums 94.5%, Currants 73.4%, Table grapes 72.0%). In the livestock sector, the production of beef has a self-sufficiency rate of 43.9%, cow's milk 80%, sheep and goat meat 100%, eggs 99% and chicken meat 6.9% and honey 85.0%

The export value of agricultural products in 2021 was 92.6 mil. €, which had an increase of 18.7% compared to 2020. The import value of agricultural products was 965.6 mil. €, which represents an increase of 26.2% in 2021 compared to 2020. The participation of the export of agricultural products in the total export in 2021 was 12%. The lowest participation of the import of agricultural products in the total import was in 2021 with a participation of 21%, while the coverage of import with export is 9.6%. In 2021, the majority or 55.7% of exported agricultural products were realized in CEFTA countries, 34.2% in EU countries and the rest of 10.1% in other countries. In contrast to export, the largest part of imported products or 48.4% is from EU countries, followed by CEFTA countries with 27.6% and other countries with 24.0%. During 2021, the total amount of agro loans disbursed is 479.8 mil. €, while the interest rate has decreased for banks from 9.3% (2020) to 8.0% (2021), whereas for MFIs from 20.5% that was in 2020, the rate increased again and reached 21% in 2021. The participation of agricultural loans in relation to commercial loans is decreasing every year, now their participation is only 2.1%. In 2020, the support of the agriculture sector continued based on the two programs designed: The Direct Payments Program and the Rural Development Program. In 2021, the total support through direct payments was € 28.9 mil, and a total of 27 sectors were supported. The total number of farmers applying in 2021 was 25.742, of which 24.958 (97%) were beneficiaries and rejected (3%). In 2021, the largest amount of subsidies was allocated to: dairy cows (17%), wheat (11%), sheep and goats, bees, corn, vegetables (from 10%), vineyards (9%), milk according to quality (8%) and orchards (6%), while the rest of 9% to other sectors. The planned budget within the Rural Development Program for the year 2020-2021 was 29.34 million. €. Based on the data reported by the Directorate for Project Authorization in ADA, during the period 2020-2021, a total of 304 projects were authorized in the amount of 9.7 million. €, of which for measure 101 (Investments in physical assets in agricultural economies), the value of the support was a total of 5.8 million. € or 59.5% of the budget, Measure 103 (Investments in physical assets in the processing and marketing of agricultural products), the value of the support was 2.6 million. € with 26.9%, Masen 302 (Diversification of farms and development of rural businesses) 1.2 million. € (12.4%), as well as the Measure for irrigation of agricultural lands 1.13%.






Trade of Agricultural Products






