REGULATION NO. 2006/41

**ON THE PROMULGATION OF THE LAW ON HUNTING
ADOPTED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF KOSOVO**

The Special Representative of the Secretary-General,

Pursuant to the authority given to him under United Nations Security Council resolution (UNSCR) 1244 (1999) of 10 June 1999,

In conformity with sections 9.1.44 and 9.1.45 of the Constitutional Framework for Provisional Self-Government in Kosovo (UNMIK Regulation No. 2001/9 of 15 May 2001),

Taking into account a communication from the President of the Assembly of Kosovo, dated 27 December 2005, concerning the Law on Hunting adopted by the Assembly of Kosovo on 16 December 2005,

Noting that the provisions of the Law shall be without prejudice to the authority of the Special Representative of the Secretary-General under UNSCR 1244 (1999) or his reserved powers and responsibilities under the Constitutional Framework for Provisional Self-Government in Kosovo,

Hereby promulgates, effective as of the date of signature, the Law on Hunting adopted by the Assembly of Kosovo (Law No.02/L-53) attached to the present Regulation, provided that:

(a) The Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Rural Development shall implement article 8.2 of the Law in close coordination with the UNMIK Police and KFOR;

(b) The Law, and in particular article 45.4 thereof, shall be implemented in conformity with UNMIK Regulation No. 2001/7 of 21 February 2001, as amended, on the Authorization of Possessions of Weapons in Kosovo; and

(c) The words in the country in article 6.2 shall be replaced by “in Kosovo”.

The change in (c) above shall be reflected in the final official text of the Law.
