

REGULATION NO. 2006/58

**ON THE PROMULGATION
OF THE LAW ON FISHERY AND AQUACULTURE
ADOPTED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF KOSOVO**

The Acting Special Representative of the Secretary-General,

Pursuant to the authority given to him under United Nations Security Council resolution 1244 (1999) of 10 June 1999,

In conformity with Chapter 5.1 (n) and section 9.1.26 of the Constitutional Framework for Provisional Self-Government in Kosovo (UNMIK Regulation No. 2001/9 of May 2001),

Taking into account the communication from the President of the Assembly of Kosovo dated 26 October 2006 concerning the Law on Fishery and Aquaculture adopted by the Assembly of Kosovo on 10 October 2006,

Noting that the provisions of the Law shall be without prejudice to the authority of the Special Representative of the Secretary-General under UNSCR 1244 (1999) or his reserved powers and responsibilities under the Constitutional Framework for Provisional Self-Government in Kosovo,

Hereby promulgates, effective as of the date of signature, the Law on Fishery and Aquaculture adopted by the Assembly of Kosovo (Law No. 02/L-85) attached to the present Regulation, provided that:

(a) Articles 16.4 and 16.5 shall be implemented in conformity with the Law on Public Procurement as promulgated by UNMIK Regulation 2004/3;

(b) Article 25.2 (d) shall be implemented in conformity with the applicable legislation governing land use and ownership matters;

(c) In Article 25.2 (e) the word “competent” shall be added before the words “land management authority”; and

(d) Article 25.2 (f) shall be implemented in conformity with the Law on Procedure for the Award of Concessions as promulgated by UNMIK Regulation No. 2006/27.

These changes shall be reflected in the final official text of the Law.
